Wind Warning for:

= New = Colchester County – Cobequid Bay – Cumberland County – Minas Shore. A wind warning has been issued for these areas for tonight. Monitor the public forecasts and weather conditions... listen for updated statements.

=DISCUSSION=

A low pressure area in Quebec will move eastward to the Gulf of St Lawrence by Thursday morning. This system will bring strong southerly winds to the Cobequid Bay and Minas Shore overnight with winds gusting to 90 km/h. END/

HEAVY RAINFALL WARNING FOR:

CAB PRIORITY CODE 2

= New = Muncho-Stone Mountain Parks – Fort Nelson. Rainfall amounts between 20 and 60 millimeters are forecast to fall tonight and tomorrow. This is a warning that heavy rain is imminent or occurring in these regions. Monitor weather conditions. Listen for updated statements.

=DISCUSSION=

An upper low moving from Central BC Northeastward over the Rocky Mountains overnight will bring significant moisture with it. As the low crosses the continental divide a Northeasterly upslope flow will cause moderate to heavy rainfalls especially over the upslope areas west of Fort Nelson and the mountains. Rain will begin overnight and continue Thursday and Friday. Please refer to the latest public forecasts for further details. END/UWE
